Some doors can appear grey & daunting, not looking anything like an opportunity – sometimes it is just because they in a shadow, or maybe we create the shadow






Make all your doors blue

- send a letter template or personal
- Email via their website
- Tweet & cc in your @MP
- Arrange meeting local 'surgery'
- Invite to your service or event

- Work out what you would like from them
- Make it 'local' % pop, local impacts, local benefits
- Contact your Trust Comms team for advice
- CSP –great advice & support
- Research them- website, Facebook page, tweets, website, Weekly News, their personal campaigns
- Think how you can be a resource for your MP
- Find out their parliamentary committees
- Help positive PR- local media, tweet, local news, Trust newsletter, Facebook



MPs- campaigning on your behalf

- Can write letter to relevant dept, official or Minister
- Can make personal appointment to discuss issue
- Raise question in House of Commons
- written question to a Minister- required to answer
- Ask them to an event
- To pledge their support
- To write to local media on your behalf


Eastbourne physiotherapy expert
