Statement by the European Region of World Confederation for Physiotherapy (ER-WCPT) and the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy (CSP) on the outcome of the UK referendum

On the 23rd June 2016, the citizens of the United Kingdom voted to leave the European Union. We know that many member organisations will be concerned about the possible implications of this vote for physiotherapy collaboration in Europe.

Catherine Pope, Chair of CSP Council, has confirmed this result will have no impact on their membership of ER-WCPT. The members of the CSP are committed to working with colleagues across Europe for the benefit of patient care and physiotherapy internationally.

ER-WCPT already includes the physiotherapy organisations from countries in Europe but not within the European Union. We will continue to work together to achieve the objectives agreed during our last General Meeting and to raise the profile of our unique profession.

We know that all our members, wherever located, wish to continue collaborating with one another and we will do everything to ensure that this is achieved.
